1. Long Answer

Problem 1.1) The solution is $y = \frac{1}{2}(x^2 - x + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2}e^{-2x})$.

Problem 1.2) a.) $\frac{dx}{dt} = r - kx(t)$.

b.) $x(t) = \frac{r}{k} + \frac{C}{k}e^{-kt}$

c.) $x(t) = \frac{r}{k} + \frac{kc_0 - r}{k}e^{-kt}$

Problem 1.3) a.) $T_3(x) = (x - 1) - \frac{1}{2}(x - 1)^2 + \frac{1}{3}(x - 1)^3$

b.) $\ln(\frac{3}{2}) \approx T_3(\frac{3}{2}) = \frac{5}{12}$

c.) $|R_3(x)| \leq E = \frac{1}{4} = 0.25$.
